



EXPANDED OUTSIDE DINING OPTIONS AVAILABLE FOR CITY OF SUGAR LAND RESTAURANTS

The City of Sugar Land is committed to helping restaurants open and stay open as safely as possible during these unprecedented times.

Sugar Land City Council passed Ordinance No. 2207 which temporarily suspends certain regulations applicable to the use of parking lots/spaces. Restaurant owners interested in temporarily offering outdoor seating in parking lots to maximize onsite dining capacity will need to make a request to the city.

- Requests will require submittal of a site layout plan designating parking spaces to be temporarily converted to outdoor dining space and to show compliance with location and safety conditions required by Sugar Land Ordinance 2207
- Requests will be reviewed within 3 business days
- Letter Agreement will be required to implement the agreed upon layout plan and conditions
- Temporary seating will cease once occupancy restrictions are lifted on indoor dining or state of disaster is terminated
- Compliance with Texas Alcoholic Beverage Commission's (TABC) regulations is required
